## What is Bullying?

In our school a bully is someone who hurts someone more than once, by using behaviour which is meant to hurt, frighten or upset another person.

### Bullying can be.....

**Emotional:** Hurting people's feelings, leaving you out.

**Physical:** Punching, kicking, spitting, hitting or pushing.

**Verbal:** Being teased, name calling.

**Cyber:** Saying unkind things by text, e-mail, MSN messenger or Facebook.

**Prejudice related:** Saying or doing unkind things because of how someone looks or behaves.

## **Start Telling Other People!**

*If you are bullied*

**DO:**

*Tell someone straight away*

**DON'T:**

*Do what they say  
Get angry or look upset  
Hit them  
Think it's your fault  
Hide it*

**What should I do if I see someone else is being bullied?**

- **Tell** an adult or friend what you have seen
- **Don't** walk away and ignore the bullying
- **Don't** stay silent or the bullying will keep happening
- **Don't** be a by-stander and watch what happens

**All the staff and governors will work together to:**

- Make our school a place where everyone can feel safe and happy.
